The City of Johannesburg hereby invites Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) industry solution providers (herein after also referred to as the respondent or respondents) to submit a proposal to supply, implement and operate an Automatic Fare Collection System Inclusive of the relevant peripheral equipment to be installed at BRT stations and BRT Buses.

- Details of experience in carrying out similar projects
- Brief CVs of key personnel to be utilised in this project
- Economic basis of supply
- Level of Black Economic Empowerment from Shareholding, management, purchases from Black Business, sub contracting to Black business and other initiative perspectives.
- A valid Tax clearance certificate

**SELECTION APPROACH**

The selection process will be based on the criteria provided in the RFP document. Tenders which satisfy the City of Johannesburg that they are able to fulfil their obligations and can comply with the technical specifications in terms of the tender documents will be evaluated on the unit rates and prices, Tender Price, technical compatibility, capability, qualifications to the tender and BEE status.
